2. If you have not registered in our system yet, you will click on "Register" and fill out the registration information. (You do **NOT** need a join code or to choose a day of the week)
3. Input your information and read the insurance waiver, make sure to check "Yes" at the bottom of the waiver. **Remember your password to sign in for future registrations.**
4. Go to the Calendar/Events page and scroll to "**October 9th**"
5. Click on "**A & R Employees Union Build-A-Thon**"
6. Click "**Sign up**" at the bottom of the page. You will receive a confirmation with details of the day and updates as we get closer to our build date.

Details of the Day

- **Please arrive by 7:45 a.m.** It is **mandatory** to participate in our **Safety Speech at 8:00** in order to volunteer.
- After the Safety Speech you will be **TRAINED** on the job to be done.
- **The day typically ends by 3:00** (or earlier, at the discretion of the Site Supervisor). You will have a break in the morning and at lunchtime.
- **Wear appropriate clothing:** T-shirts and Rugged Pants/Shorts - NO loose clothing that cannot be tucked in to outerwear such as scarves, etc. Be prepared that clothes can be ruined while volunteering. Working with construction materials can destroy clothing, coats and footwear.
- **Dress in layers** - be sure to dress appropriately according to the weather.
- **Wear protective footwear** (solid soles and covered toes: no flip flops, loafers, high heels/ high heel boots and dress shoes).
- **Lunch will be provided.**
- **Car pool.** City streets are tough to park!
- **If we have to cancel due to weather/emergency the decision will be made the day before or 6:30 a.m.**
- Have a GREAT TIME and thank you for volunteering!!!

We understand that life happens and plans change. Please let us know ASAP, if you are unable to join us. Construction crews rely on volunteer numbers and often homeowners are working along-side our groups. "No-shows" do not reflect the spirit of the Habitat Mission, so please keep in touch!
