The name of the Winkler Award and the Zilber Award winners will be displayed at the A&R Headquarters on a commemorative plaque.

Primary considerations in the selection process are

- 1. Financial needs (including income level, number of siblings, etc.)
- 2. Scholastic record
- 3. Community service and extracurricular activities (including employment).

Scholarship recipients will be announced at A&Rs annual convention on April 13, 2023.

Completed applications must be <u>received</u> at the Union office by <u>4:30 p.m. March 31, 2023</u> accompanied by copies of school transcripts and 2022 parental/guardian tax returns or W-2 forms (if the parents' tax returns are not complete). NO EXCEPTIONS.
