One of the applicants will receive a \$2,500 Mike Winkler Scholarship Award.

The name of the Winkler Award and the Zilber Award winners will be displayed at the A&R Headquarters on a commemorative plaque.

Primary considerations in the selection process are

- 1. Financial needs (including income level, number of siblings, etc.)
- 2. Scholastic record
- 3. Community service and extracurricular activities (including employment).

Scholarship recipients will be announced at A&Rs annual convention on April 17, 2025.

Completed applications must be <u>received</u> at the Union office by <u>4:30 p.m. March 31, 2025</u> accompanied by copies of school transcripts and 2025 parent/guardian W-2 tax forms. NO EXCEPTIONS.
